Through programs, workshops, retreats and events, the Go Girls Foundation provides a supportive and inclusive environment to enable women to take meaningful action towards a fulfilling future.

- Women who have experienced domestic violence to move towards independence
- Migrant woman who have faced social isolation to engage in their community
- Women who have experienced homelessness to overcome their circumstances
- Women recovering from breast cancer to find a new pathway
- Women in the workplace to take on leadership roles
- Women in business to grow

Combining practical skills and personal development.

Employment skills development combined with positive psychology approaches empowers women to gain a stronger sense of self and take more control of their lives.

Our unique programs are run by fully qualified psychologists and facilitators. Each program is adapted to meet the needs of different groups while at the same time delivering specific outcomes.

All programs are underpinned by the values of compassion, acceptance and courage.

Workshops ignite possibilities and help women to better understand who they are and what they want from life by freely exploring their dreams and passions.

The key driver for change is confident, supported and planned action taking.

This approach brings together an inspirational energy that is driven by real change and success helps women harness the momentum of redefining their future.

Go Girls Work Ready Program.

Assisting long-term unemployed women to become work ready, allowing for a more independent life.

Who does it support?

The Go Girls Work Ready Program includes women of all ages from diverse backgrounds: women who are long-term unemployed, women who have experienced domestic violence, women from migrant backgrounds and women experiencing difficulty. We work closely with partner organisations to interview and screen participants, selecting those who show a genuine need and desire for change.

How is the Go Girls Work Ready Program different?

Unlike many employment courses, the Go Girls Work Ready Program develops practical job skills, while also placing emphasis on positive psychology and offering continued support from highly skilled psychologists and facilitators. Every woman who participates in the program graduates with a plan, empowering them with a strong sense of their future. A personal approach is applied to planning taking into consideration job, career, financial and life circumstances and aspirations. This emphasis on personal development helps women to overcome obstacles that traditionally get in the way of successfully gaining and maintaining employment.

What are the impacts?

Throughout the four-month program, the participants display increased levels of responsibility and take more directed and focused action. The women gain a stronger sense of self and have more control of their life and as a result whole families and communities can be influenced in a positive way.
